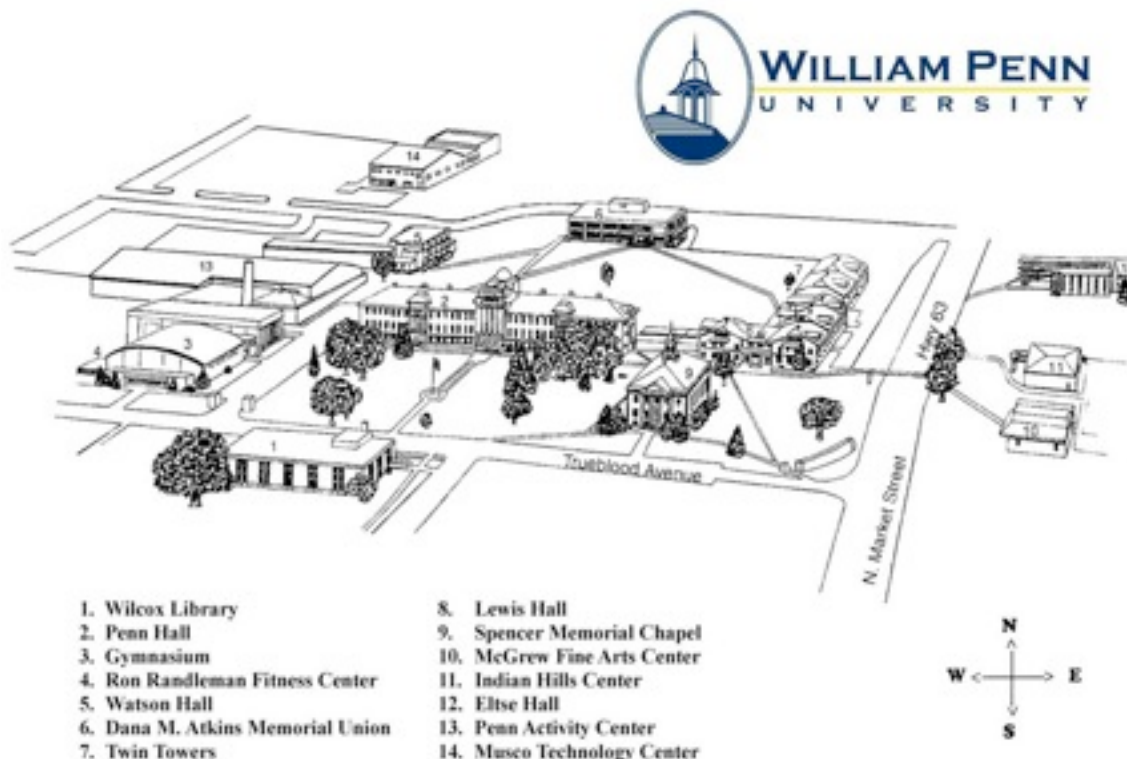


Friends Association for Higher Education 2010 Annual Conference William Penn University, June 16-20

Registration/Parking : Registration will be in the Atkins Student Union (see map below) beginning at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, June 16. Registration will be open until 8:00 p.m. and open again from 8:30-9:30 on Thursday and Friday morning. The Union parking on the east side of the Union is available for conference attendees.

Meals

Please wear your name badge to authenticate that you have prepaid for meals. Conference meals run from Wednesday night dinner through Sunday Lunch. Those whose plans require leaving prior to Sunday lunch (12:30-1:30 p.m.) and who desire a sack lunch/box meal should sign up for this alternative at registration. These grab-n-go meals will be available by 11:00 a.m.

For those purchasing individual meals, prices are: breakfast, \$5.38; lunch, \$7.53; dinner, \$9.68.

Airport Shuttle from to Oskaloosa to the Des Moines Airport (DSM)

The airport is about a one hour drive from Oskaloosa; Shuttles will run as needed Sunday morning/afternoon. A signup for rides to the airport will be made available at the registration table; please indicate your need for a shuttle ride no later than Saturday noon. Cost is \$15 paid at the time of service.

Cash/ATM Machine

An ATM machine is located in the lower level hallway of Atkins Union near the University bookstore. During business hours (W-F/8-5) the William Penn Business Office is pleased to cash personal checks up to \$50.

Conference Book Store

The conference book store is located in the Mahaska State Bank Room adjacent to the Atkins Union Lobby/conference registration area. The bookstore will be open:

Computers/Internet Service

There are public computers in Wilcox Library and the Atkins Student Union Lounge. Wireless internet service is widely available on campus including the buildings involved in the conference (excluding the Twin Towers Residence Hall which requires an ethernet cable--not provided).

Recreation/Exercise: The Penn Activity Center houses a full complement of exercise equipment, an indoor track, two basketball courts and almost 50 yards of indoor turf. The Penn Activity Center is open: 7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. Wed/Thu/Fri; 7:00 a.m.-2:30 Saturday

A paved bike/walking path is within a few minutes of campus: cross Highway 63/Market St on the pedestrian bridge east of Lewis Hall; follow the sidewalk around McGrew Fine Arts Center walk east on the street to Lacy Drive; walk north to Sheriff Ave and then east to N. 3rd St. Trail access is at the corner of N 3rd St and Sheriff Ave. The route to the bike/walking path offers no sidewalks from Penn.

Swimming is available at the local YMCA (about a 20 minute walk from campus). The YMCA is located at the corner of C Ave East and N 3rd St.

FAHE Membership Dues Renewal

The annual conference is the best time to renew your FAHE membership dues (\$60/individual;\$75/family; \$15/student). You may renew your dues either at the time of registration or anytime the conference bookstore is open.

Laundry Facilities

Each suite has a washer and dryer available. You will need quarters (\$.75 each for wash/dry). Change can be obtained from the University business office during regular business hours W-F/8-5. Should you need laundry detergent check with conference bookstore during bookstore hours.

University Bookstore

The William Penn University Bookstore is open Wed/Thu from 11:00 a.m.--5:30 p.m. and Friday from 9:00 a.m. till noon. The bookstore is located on the lower level of Atkins Union.

Wilcox Library

Wilcox Library hours: Wed/Thu, June 16/17--8 am to 8 pm; Fri, June 18--8 am to 5 pm; Sat, June 19--1:30-4:30 pm; closed Sunday.

Jones Mideast Collection

Wilcox Library houses the Jones Mideast Collection; please ask at the front desk for access. For those interested, a guided tour of the Collection is available to conference attendees Friday, June 18 from 1:30 -2:30 p.m. The Collection is located on the lower level of Wilcox Library.

A. Willard and Christina Jones, Penn alumni and the major donors of the Collection, lived and worked in Palestine from 1922-1962. Willard was headmaster of Friends Boys School in Ramallah, Jordan; Christina served as matron and teacher.
