

ASQ - Fall 2008

Students completing the ASQ were asked to rate the importance of various characteristics of colleges. The table below indicates the characteristics the students felt were very important and their rating of Earlham and the admissions overlap schools. The characteristics marked with an X were considered to be very important to at least 50% of the admitted students. Characteristics for which Earlham was rated higher than competitor were those for which the mean rating of Earlham was higher than the mean rating for our competitor.

When admitted students rated the personal attention they felt they would get from colleges, Earlham rated higher than Oberlin, Grinnell and Beloit. Student diversity was considered superior at Earlham when compared to Oberlin, Grinnell, College of Wooster and Beloit. Characteristics in which our overlap schools were considered superior by the student respondents included quality of academic facilities, special academic programs offered, quality of social life, and cost of attendance. Earlham was rated above the College of Wooster in value for the price.
